Dear Counsel,

I spoke with Ms. Sue Moon, the DCFS worker assigned to the Pavlovich case. She informed me that she spoke with Aneta, Sloba and all three minor children regarding allegations that Aneta hit the children. Ms. Moon believes that Aneta is not coaching the children as to what to say. She believes that Sloba is coaching, or at least suggesting to the children, what to say.

Sue reported there was no evidence of physical abuse and the children denied physical abuse by mom. Again, she did not believe that Aneta was coaching the children. She believes that the children are very comfortable with their mom. Ms. Moon will recommend that these allegations are unfounded.

Gloria - If this changes your willingness to respond to the proposed Parenting Allocation Plan, please advise me of this and advise me of your plan.

Ofc. Martinez and I responded to 1000 Pfingsten Rd., Shabonee School for a standby at the request of the principal, John Panozzo.

Upon my arrival I met with the school principal, Panozzo and social worker, Kay Gifford. Kay related on 02/12/18 at approx. 0930 hrs. she spoke with Juv 1 and her mother, Aneta Hadzi-Tanovic regarding physical abuse Juv 1's brother's, Juv 2 and 3 were experiencing at the hands of their father, Slobadan Pavlovich. Juv 1 stated approx. 1 week ago, she saw her father squeezing Juv 2 and 3's head and chest when he was upset. Juv 2 stated to Gifford his mother has spanked his buttocks with a wooden spoon and threatened to strike him with an open hand. Juv 2 did tell Gifford that he was squeezed by his father approx. 1 month ago not last week like Juv 1 alleged.

Juv 1 stated she did not feel comfortable going home with her father today. Juv 2 stated would be ok leaving with him. Gifford stated she is aware of a current DCFS investigation (DCFS Case: 2338447A) involving the 3 children. Gifford already spoke to DCFS who related an investigator would be enroute to the school. Gifford nor Panozza felt comfortable releasing the children to their father.

While on scene, Gifford spoke to DCFS investigator, Richard De Lahaza via TX (312-718-6282) who related the following: The original investigator, Hilda Stanley was off but he would be enroute to speak with the family. He stated that unless the father, Slobodan had a court order mandating the 3 Juv's release to him than they were to go with their mother, Aneta. He stated the kids were to remain together. At this time, the 3 Juvs were not to be released or picked up by their father on Tuesday, 02/13/18.

Aneta arrived at Shabonee School and I spoke her. Aneta who advised me of the above DCFS investigation. She stated an FI interview was to be conducted with the kids possibly Wednesday or Thursday. Slobodan has no knowledge of this interview and she was advised by DCFS to not let him know.

I spoke to Juv 1 and 2 with Gifford present and Juv 1 stated she did not feel comfortable leaving with her father and wanted to go with her mother. Juv 2 stated he had no problem leaving with his father and would like to. Juv 2 stated his father does not hit him but his mother has spanked him in the past. My attempts to speak with, De Lahaza were met with negative results. His voicemail was full and I could not leave a message. I was advised by Panozzo that De Lahaza did arrive to the school after R/Os left the area at approx. 1620 hrs. He was advised the children were released to their mother. Panozzo did not know if De Lahaza would be speaking with the children tonight.

I advised Slobadan that the 3 children were going home with their mother per DCFS. He stated he would handle this matter "in the courts". He was advised not to pick up the children tomorrow either. Slobadan left the area without issue.

Juv 1 and 2 left the school with their mother. Prior to leaving Aneta related she was concerned that Slobadan would show up at the Juv's soccer practice Tuesday at 1600 hrs or Wednesday at 1900 hrs. The practices are held at Athletico, 1900 Old Willow Rd., Northbrook and she was advised to call NPD if there are any issues there. She was also advised to call 911 if any other issues arise.

GUARDIAN AD LITEM UPDATED REPORT
REGARDING EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND PARENTING TIME

On August 25, 2016, I was appointed *Guardian Ad Litem* for the minor children Stefan Pavlovich (hereinafter “Stefan”), born March 13, 2006, and Katarina Pavlovich (hereinafter “Katarina”), and Marko Pavlovich (hereinafter “Marko”) both born May 19, 2008 (hereinafter collectively “minor children”).

On December 18, 2017, a court order was entered regarding the children’s band participation. It states in pertinent part:

The children’s band participation shall constitute an “extracurricular activity” and as such, any issue regarding the same shall be arbitrated by the *Guardian Ad Litem* in accordance with the Allocation Judgment entered on June 12, 2017.

As such, I met with the children to investigate the band issue. Out of the three children, only Katarina expressed an interest in band.

On January 28, 2018, I received an email from Aneta Pavlovich (hereinafter “Aneta”), in which she states that I secretly interrogated the children and that I have no jurisdiction or authority regarding band or orchestra, as they are curricular classes, not extracurricular. Since entry of the December 18, 2017 order, there has been police and DCFS involvement, as well as the filing of *Petitioner’s Ex Parte Emergency Motion for Temporary Suspension of Respondent’s Parenting Time, or in the Alternative, for Respondent’s Parenting Time to be Supervised*. Said pleading was found to be an emergency and was heard by this Court on February 14, 2018. I subsequently met with the children again.

On February 11, 2018, I met with Marko. Marko told me that Aneta speaks to Stefan and Katarina without him. Marko believes that Aneta does this because she knows he will not lie about Sloba. Marko also told me about Stefan being grounded, but that Stefan was not locked

in his room. Marko said Stefan was able to use the restroom and that he also had access to his school computer.

On February 15, 2018, I met with Stefan and Katarina, individually. I first met with Stefan, who again stated that he does not want to participate in band. Due to a miscommunication to the parents on my part in which I stated that two of the children are interested in band (instead of saying two of the children are *not* interested in band), Sloba believed that Stefan had told me that he was interested in band. Stefan told me Sloba was mad about Stefan changing stories regarding band, and grounded him by sending him to his room. Stefan said he stayed there for hours, but that he was able to use the restroom and have dinner. I apologized to Stefan for my oversight, as this caused Stefan to be grounded. I also told Stefan that I would suggest to Sloba to remove the locks off the bedroom doors, as they are on the outside of the door. I have sent a letter to the parties regarding the same.

Stefan told me that he told Mr. Bultz, his counselor, of abuse by his dad. I explained to Stefan how, as mandated reporters, Mr. Bultz had to report Stefan's allegation to DCFS. Stefan told me that Sloba sometimes squeezes his head, that Sloba does the claw move on his head when they play wrestle. I told Stefan I would recommend no more play wrestling. I also reminded Stefan that soccer is coming up. Stefan told me he still wants to play soccer.

After meeting with Stefan, I met with Katarina, who also told me about Stefan being grounded. Katarina told me that the room Stefan was in was not locked, and that Stefan had his school computer with him. Katarina also told me that Aneta said she wants them with her. I reminded Katarina that the judge decides parenting time—not me, not Aneta, and not Sloba.

On February 26, 2018, counsel for Sloba forwarded an email from Sloba in which he says that Marko, Katarina, and Stefan spoke with their respective school social worker and explained why they lied and the pressure they were under.

On March 6, 2018, I met with all three children again, per Sloba's request, to investigate the statements the children said Aneta made. I first met with Marko, who said Aneta told him and his siblings that Sloba pays me and the judge to get his way, that some judge put an 8 year old kid and a 12 year old kid in jail, that kids went to jail because they wanted to go with dad, and that when they passed by the Northbrook Police Department she said "Oh, there's the jail." In addition, Marko also told me that Aneta thinks he's "bad" and that she doesn't let Katarina or Stefan talk or play with him. Marko said he cannot have playdates at Sloba's house anymore, because Aneta tells his friends' parents that Sloba is crazy. Marko told me he would like to spend less time with mom.

After meeting with Marko, I met with Katarina. Katarina also told me about the 8 year old and 12 year old who were thrown in jail for not visiting their father, except she believes Aneta said it wasn't just *a* judge, but *our* judge. In addition, Katarina told me that Aneta said her grandmother (Sloba's mother) is fat. Katarina said she responded by saying that all that matters is she is nice—to which Aneta responded, "Well, she's not nice." Katarina said she feels bad that Aneta put Marko to bed at 6pm on Sunday when Katarina and Stefan were allowed

to stay up until midnight. She said that Marko had attempted to play with Stefan and to watch YouTube videos with Katarina, but that Aneta did not allow Marko to do so.

Katarina said she still wants to do soccer, and that based on their schedule she can do both soccer and gymnastics. She said that Aneta does not want them (the children) to do soccer, and that in the past Aneta has said she feels sick, even though she really isn't, so that she doesn't have to take them to soccer. Katarina told me that Aneta has said she doesn't hate soccer—that she doesn't like it because dad likes it. Katarina also said that Aneta has told her that her legs (Katarina's) will get three times bigger if she continues with soccer. I explained to Katarina that one has to really train their legs and lift weights for that to happen, and that it is difficult to do so. Katarina also mentioned not being able to have playdates at Sloba's because Aneta tells other parents that Sloba is crazy and beats them (the children).

I met with Stefan last. Stefan told me that Aneta forced them to lie about Sloba. He also told me that Aneta has threatened to beat them (the children) if they lie. In addition, Stefan said that Aneta told them that the judge is being paid off, that I am being paid off, and that an 8 year old and a 12 year old were thrown in jail. It was clear to me that the children were very concerned about the possibility of being thrown in jail. As such, I went to great lengths to explain to each child that there is not a jail for children and that judges cannot throw 8 year olds or 12 year olds in jail.

When I met with Stefan, I again asked about band. Stefan said he does not want to participate in band or play the trombone, but that Aneta still makes him practice at home. Stefan said that Aneta wants him to ask his band teacher to allow him to play in concerts even though he is not in band class anymore. Stefan said the band teacher would allow this, as said teacher only cares about his band program. Stefan went as far as to say that he hates his band teacher. Stefan also pointed out that each school year Aneta would promise it would be the last year he would have to be in band, but that the following year she would insist on band again. Stefan said he has told Aneta multiple times that he does not want to play trombone or be in band.

On March 8, 2018, counsel for Sloba informed me that there was an altercation between Aneta and the children on March 7, 2018, at a Subway restaurant. It is my understanding that the children told Aneta that they wanted to go with Sloba. The children contacted Sloba, and Sloba could hear the children screaming in the background. Aneta contacted the police, who questioned the children. When the children told the officer that they wanted to go with Sloba, the officer allegedly asked the children if they were sure their dad wanted to take them. It is also my understanding that Sloba was skeptical about taking the children and violating a court order regarding Aneta's parenting time. However, Aneta agreed for the children to go with Sloba, and the officer allegedly wrote this agreement on his report.

Based on my meetings with the children and on recent events, I recommend that Aneta should not have weekday parenting time before school days and that the children attend therapy.

March 9, 2018

If Aneta continues to try to force Stefan to play the trombone and attend concerts, I suggest that Sloba make the decisions regarding the extra-curricular activities.

I also recommend that Sloba be in charge of decision-making regarding therapy Therapists I recommend, and who I believe are covered under Sloba's insurance include:

I need your help, I have a huge problem; my dad goes crazy mad and throws things around me, and yells and swears at me.

He puts so much pressure on me, my brother, and on my sister when we are going to talk to DCFS, Child Rep, and GAL. My dad forces us to lie for him, he forces us to say what he wants.

He yells, screams, swears really bad every three words, and threatens to us that we will go in time out for hours if we don't lie for him. I told this to Child Rep, and GAL, and they did nothing.

My dad is squeezing my head as hard as he can, and he is drilling in my chest, with his fists. I am crying and yelling for him to stop, but he continues. He laughs and says its funny, and I tell him to stop. My dad squeezes my stomach as hard as he can and also he makes my ribs crack. It hurts me a lot and I hate it and I cry and he won't stop. My dad does the same thing to my brother Marko, but he's too scared to say it. My dad locks me in my room for many hours sometimes a whole day.

I scream and cry for him to let me out of the bedroom, to use the toilet, but he tells me to "SHUT THE F... up!" I end up peeing in my pants or in a pencil box. My sister Katarina sees and hears all of this, and she is scared and cries in her bedroom. She told all of this to DCFS,

When I reported this to the police and DCFS, I was scared and I didn't feel safe to go with dad because of what he might do to me if I go back with him, so I refused to go with him. The police and my school told me that I don't have to go with my dad, if I don't feel safe and that I can go with my mom. I told all of this to GAL - David Pasulka. David was so biased against me, telling me that what I said didn't happen. David was telling me that I was wrong. He was telling me that my school and the Police were wrong for letting me go with my mom. David was telling me; "no that didn't happen, it happened this way!" He was also telling me that my mom is bad. I told him to stop but he continued. He was also

telling me what supposedly happened in court, and he wouldn't let me talk.

I told all of this to the police, DCFS, and nothing has changed. I am turning 12 years old on March 13, and I want to live with my mom. Can you please speed up the process, and can you please help me. Thank you for your time.
